

BOROUGH OF CASTLE SHANNON

ORDINANCE NO. 704

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CASTLE SHANNON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 666, ALSO IDENTIFIED AS CHAPTER 11, SECTIONS 51 THROUGH 53, WRITTEN ON APRIL 13, 1981, AND PREVIOUSLY AMENDED ON JULY 16, 1984; ADDING SMALLER WILD ANIMALS THAT ARE CAPABLE OF CARRYING GERMS OR DISEASES WHICH BY ANY FORM OF CONTACT OR ANY FORM OF DISCHARGE OR DEPOSIT CAN BE HARMFUL TO HUMANS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Castle Shannon as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 666 enacted April 13, 1981, and amended for the first time on July 16, 1984, and identified in the Codification of Ordinances of the Borough of Castle Shannon in Chapter 11, Sections 51 through 53, is hereby amended to include any wild animal such as a raccoon, fox, weasel or skunk, but not necessarily limited to those four, . and which animal is capable of communicating germs or disease to humans by Contact, discharge or deposit.

2. Ordinance No. 666 as amended by Ordinance No. 692, also known as Chapter II, Sections 51 through 53 of the Codification of Ordinances of the Borough of Castle Shannon, and further defined as the "Wild Cats" Ordinance, and more specifically Section 52 of the said Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 52(a) - No person, firm or corporation shall keep or maintain any type of wild animal such as a raccoon, fox, weasel or skunk, but not necessarily limited to those four, however, including those four, and any animal which can by carrying germs or disease and by any form of contact, - discharge or deposit, communicate the said disease to humans."
