

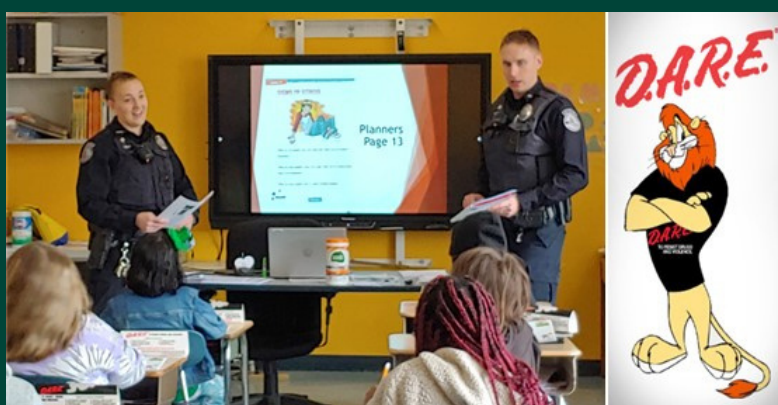

Vegetable Gardening with Penn State Master Gardener Program
Tuesday June 13th from 7:00-8:00pm

Barb Kline from the Penn State Master Gardener Program will be at the Library to talk about Vegetable Gardening! This class will cover the basics of planning your vegetable garden, preparing the soil, selecting plant and seed varieties (including hybrids and heirlooms), starting plants from seed, planting, tending your plants, troubleshooting problems, harvesting, extending the season, getting the most out of small plots, and putting the garden to bed for the winter.
