



PA American Water Co. will be restoring the street and sidewalks on lower Willow, from Castle Shannon Boulevard to the PRT tracks next to McMinn's. Work will begin Monday, July 31, and take approximately 2 weeks.

- Lower Willow traffic will be restricted to one lane, one way, traveling northward for the duration of the work.
- Lower Willow and Castle Shannon Boulevard can be accessed by taking Rt. 88 to Rockwood, then turning northward toward Castle Shannon Boulevard.
- Lower Willow CANNOT be accessed from Castle Shannon Boulevard for the duration of the work.
- Work will be performed from 6am to 6pm, Monday through Friday.
- There will be NO on-street parking from 6am to 6pm during the duration of the work.
- The sidewalk from Vinnie's Barbershop to McMinn's will be closed for the week of July 31 from 6am to 6pm, although the contractor will be sure to provide access to residents and customers of your business.
- The James St. parking lot will remain open.
- Waste Management trucks will be collecting trash in the work zone earlier than usual for the next two Thursdays; please have your trash out by 5:00 am on August 3 and 10, but no earlier than 6:00pm the evening before.

The contractor will start with the sidewalk repair and restoration portion of the work, then move on to demo of the yellow brick roadway pavers. Milling and paving the entire length, from Castle Shannon Boulevard to the tracks, will occur at a later date. That date is unknown at this time, but we will update you as soon as possible.

Businesses: please alert your employees, customers, and delivery drivers to the upcoming restrictions, even if your business is not located on Lower Willow Ave.

Residents: please alert any visitors, in-home care providers, or delivery drivers to the upcoming restrictions.
