As part of our commitment to provide safe and reliable natural gas service to our customers, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania will be completing a significant investment to replace natural gas pipelines in your neighborhood.

Our work mainly affects customers along portions of Castle Shannon Boulevard, Crystal Drive, Arlington Park Drive, Cooke Lane, Mt. Lebanon Boulevard, Gypsy Lane, Rockwood Avenue, James Street, and Willow Avenue between St Anne Street and Baldwin Street. Work is expected through the fall of 2024 weather permitting from 7 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Friday with Saturday work possible. Motorists can expect road closures and lane restrictions during working hours only.

During this time, you may see our contractors or employees doing work and inspections on your street, public rights-of -ways and customers' properties and meters. This project may include replacing your service line and moving any indoor gas meters outside at no additional cost to you. However, this stage of the project will not occur until after the upgraded pipeline has been installed.

Please use extreme caution when traveling through our work zone. Please slow down and obey flaggers and all posted signs including detours and parking restrictions. We apologize for any inconvenience and will make every effort to limit traffic restrictions.

*Please note traffic will be restricted on Rockwood Avenue and James Street between Willow Avenue and Library Rd (SR88) during working hours only till Spring 2024 (weather permitting).

We appreciate your patience and cooperation on this important project to maintain safe and reliable natural gas service to homes and businesses in

Hamilton Park




The Upper and Lower sections of Hamilton Park are moving along swiftly!


Last Thursday of the Month Evening Book Discussion Thursday, February 29th from 7:00PM-8:00PM
