- Be contacted by a police officer regarding your submission

You can sign up for the No Solicitation subscription through the Castle
Shannon Police Department!

The residential "DO NOT SOLICIT" list will be provided to vendors when they apply for soliciting permits. Only the address will show and no personal information. Solicitors who violate the ordinance by visiting residents on the list risk citations and revocation of their permit.

Trash and Recycling Bin Delivery

Waste Management is close to delivering the new trash and recycling bins to residents in Castle Shannon. You can expect these to arrive between Wednesday, March 27th and Tuesday, April 2nd. Once bins are delivered, the updated automatic trash service will begin the week of April 8th.

As a reminder, if you want to switch to the smaller trash bin you will have the opportunity after two months of using the larger bins. There will be no additional cost to you when switching if done within six months. After six

months, there will be a fee. More information on how to change the bin size will be included in an informational packet when the bins are delivered.

Make & Take Multi-Generational Pen Workshop Saturday, March 9th at 11:00am


Come join us for this fun, spring-themed, multi-generational make and take workshop. The fee is \$15 per person.
